He started losing popularity in the 60ies. In 1976, he married Priscilla and they had a baby girl named Lisa Marie. He did his comeback in 1968. But in 1973, the couple divorced. Elvis then became addicted to drugs and put on weight. He gave his last concert in 1977 in Indianapolis. On August 16, 1977 he died of heart failure. He was 42 years old.
