- 6. Mr. Neal purchased apple cider for himself and three friends. He spent a total of \$7. How much was each glass of cider?
- 7. Lucy made a pumpkin pie to sell at a bake sale. She cut it into 6 slices and sold each slice for \$1.25. How much money will she make if she sells the entire pie?
- 8. Dave and his sister picked out two pumpkins at the pumpkin patch. The pumpkins cost \$0.47 per pound. David's pumpkin weighed 13.24 pounds and his sister's pumpkin weighed 10.6 pounds. How much did they pay for both pumpkins?
- 9. Monique needs 2.75 cups of sugar for a pie recipe. She wants to make 5 pies. How many cups of sugar will she need?
- 10. Isabella purchased 14.62 yards of fabric to make her costume. She needs to cut it into three 4.2-yard pieces. How much fabric will she have leftover?
