



## Harmful or Not?

The rain forest provides many useful products for people. What is done to obtain these products is something harmful to the rain forest. Any activity that involves *deforestation* is harmful to the rain forest's survival. Deforestation is the destroying of forests by cutting down trees to clear land for farms and other reasons.

tapping rubber from trees to make tires	producing palm oil made from the fruits and seeds of palm trees

gathering honey from bees	clearing land for small farms
cutting down trees for lumber	gathering extracts from plants for medicines
