
Exploding box to fit Candyhouse

This exploding box template has been made for you to ensure it fits within the Candyhouse which is found on the Jingle Jangle Christmas CD. i've created this template because the Candyhouse is not a square shape so you need to ensure you have the correct measurements to make the exploding box.

If you wish to make a standard square exploding box you can still use these instructions just substitute the measurements as highlighted at the end of the instructions.




- 1. Take a piece of cardstock (at least 160gsm) 20cm x 20cm.
- 2. Measuring from the left edge, score the card vertically at 5.5cm from the edge.
- Measuring from the right hand edge, score the card at 5.5c, from the right hand edge.
- Turn the card around so your score lines are now going across on the horizontal.



- 5. From the left hand edge score at 6cm, and again from the right hand edge
- This should leave you with a centre section which measures 8cm x 9cm.

- 8cm x 9cm.
 7. Now cut away each corner section to give you a cross shape.
 8. Now take a piece of card 19cm x 19cm and repeat steps 2 7, using the identical same measurements. You will be left with a centre section which is 1 cm smaller.
 9. Repeat for each layer you want for your box, reducing the overall size of your card by 1cm each time, until you have the number of layers you want.
 10. Each layer will sit inside the previous one giving a 1/2cm gap all around the layer. Glue into place in the centre section and decorate as you wish!



If you want to make a lid for your box if you are using it for other things than the Candyhouse, you will need a piece of card 10cm x 11cm. Score 18mm in from each edge to give you a lip for the lid and then snip the corners and glue together.

Easy peasy lemon squeezy!
