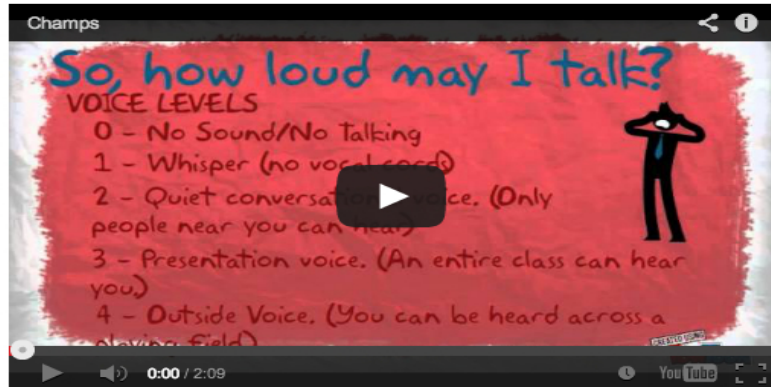














WE ARE C.H.A.M.P.S OF THE SCENIC ROUTE!

(Note: Instead of the "S" in CHAMPS standing for success, we made it stand for "SIGNAL" so that students know which musical tune to listen for when it's time to transition.
