

ThAsNKsGIVING gUcSs whO

Assembly: Print on cardstock and cut out all cards (Print big cards TWICE). Laminate if desired.

To Play: (2 players)

1. Both players select one small Pilgrim/Indian card. Do not let your opponent see it.
2. Lay out the rest of your cards face up in 4 rows of 5.
3. Take turns asking each other questions about the cards to deduce which small Pilgrim/Indian your opponent has. Turn big cards face down when they don't have characteristics you are asking about (i.e. "Does your person have a hat?" "No"...turn all people with hats face down, etc).
4. Once every card is turned face down but one, you can ask your opponent, "Is your person _____?" If it is you win the game.
