The Ark of the Covenant

The Ark...

The Ark of the Covenant was the most sacred object in the Israelite religion. It was a gold and silver chest containing the two stone tablets on which the Ten Commandments were written.

It was carried by the Levites in the wilderness and later in the Temple in Jerusalem.



The Ark was a symbol of God's presence with His people. It was a reminder of the covenant between God and Israel. The Ark was destroyed by the Babylonians in 586 BC and was never seen again.
