

### Pirate Party Toppers/Stickers

**INSTRUCTIONS:** This same template can be used to make both Cupcake Toppers and Stickers to decorate cups and party favors. For toppers, print out on cardstock. For stickers, print on a full-sized sheet. Cut out using a 2 to 2.5 inch circle or square paper punch. The stickers are ready to use. To finish the toppers cut along the perforated cut guides to a toothpick, skewer stick or straw.

### Pirate's Spyglass Wrap

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Print out the template on regular paper. Cut out the striped pattern, apply glue stick to the back, then wrap around a paper towel roll to create your Pirate's Spyglass. To make binoculars, cut in half and wrap around two toilet paper rolls then glue the rolls together.

### Pirate Jello Sails

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Print on regular paper. Cut out the striped pirate ship sails. Using a craft knife (or small hole punch), cut four punches: the top center and bottom center to make space for the toothpick. Thread a toothpick through the sails. Carefully sink toothpicks in orange gelatin then set on top of blue jello cups.

### Pirate Eye Patch Template

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Print out the template on regular paper. Place on top of blank white foam and trace over the eye patch with a pencil or pen, pressing hard enough to leave an impression on the foam. Remove paper template and cut out the foam patch. Use a hot melt patch and use a small knife to create a flap on all or the top or either side. Cut black elastic cording according to the geometry section of most craft stores to the correct size to fit around your child's head. Since it is stretchy, you'll want to cut the string a bit small so it will stay put on their head. Bring the elastic through the patch and tie off with a knot.
