First-Aid Safety Procedures

When providing first aid for bleeding or other potential injuries to coworkers, patients, follow these rules:

1. Wear rubber gloves. Do not use gloves and cut your work off and use other PPE wearing gloves.
2. Use safety goggles. Place a piece of tape over opening in face mask.
3. Wear a mask, avoid face-to-face contact, and maintain at least 6 feet of distance.
4. If your site is not certified, use medical waste bagging.
5. In the event you become exposed to infectious pathogens, seek the first aid resources, and report the exposure to your supervisor as soon as possible. Notify reports of injuries. Report to a physician.
6. Required waste must be properly bagged, sealed and stored in storage at Hospital Center Treatment.
