

Monkey Multiplication Maker

Multiply by 2, 4, 6 and 8

A game for 2 players – Use markers to cover the numbers. Players take turns to cover the numbers to make a multiplication equation covering one circle from each set, e.g. a player could cover 3, 8 and 24 for $3 \times 8 = 24$. Once a circle is covered it can't be used again. The winner is the last person to make an equation.
