



Remember those Tab-and-Slot paper toys? Or those beautiful, lithographed tin toys and army men? They were great! Simple in construction, but big on imagination, these toys could be found as cereal premiums, in punch-out books, or dug out of a candy box as a "Toy Surprise Inside!" premium or gleaming on the toy shelf at a local department store! Here, we've recaptured the flavor by combining the best of both worlds – paper and tin litho – with boilerplate graphics, simplicity of construction, and maximum playability in a small package. We hope this brings back memories or creates new ones!

Tank 18 7.5" X 10.0" 300ppi

DIRECTIONS: Cut out parts 1 and 2. Glue Part 2 to Part 1 (Fig. A). Cut red slots on ends and sides of Part 2 (Fig. B), eight slots total. Fold and glue as shown in Fig. C. Fold pointed tabs inward on Part 2. Carefully curve and glue top front (only) of body, inserting Tabs through slots cut earlier (Fig. D). Repeat process for top rear (Fig. E). Carefully curve and glue bottom front of body, also gluing to bottom flap Part 1 (Fig. F). Repeat process for top rear (Fig. G). Form 2 side sponsoons as shown (Fig. H). Insert and glue 1 into each side of Part 2. Roll and glue cannon barrels. Then insert and glue into sponsoons (Fig. I). On sponsoons, fold flaps marked "GLUE" inward, leaving top and bottom as tabs. Insert and glue 1 into each side of Part 2. Make sure they are facing forward (Fig. J, Fig. K). Model is complete.
