

# » HOUSE RULES

## PARADISE ISLAND RESORT

- On arrival, all Unit occupants are to read rules and regulations and then complete registration form with their full name, address & emergency contact details, ie. Parents/guardian etc. Access to allotted apartments will not be granted until ALL registered guests have understood, agreed and signed the House Rules.
- No keys to units will be issued until all occupants have arrived and completed the registration forms and obtained their photo identification. Only one set of keys will be issued per apartment. Replacement cost is \$80.00 each.
- Should you have a motor vehicle, there is only one allocated space per apartment. All other vehicles must be kept off-site. Unauthorised vehicles will be towed off the premises at the Owners expense for recovery.
- Any unauthorised person found to be sneaking into the building to any unit will warrant instant eviction to unit occupiers.
- All noise in units to cease at 10:00pm sharp.
- No alcohol to be consumed in public areas of the property.
- Under no circumstances will yelling, whistling or spitting from balconies or windows be permitted.
- Alcohol will be confiscated from anyone under the age of 18.
- The consumption of illegal substances is not permitted under any circumstances within the resort. Offenders will be reported to the police.
- No glass (bottles, containers, etc) to be taken on the premises. Plastic bottles (\$3.00 per bottle) and funnels are available at Reception.
- Careless or deliberate misuse of any fire fighting equipment or the use of lifts will result in possible \$500 fee and/or immediate eviction. Any charges from the Qld Fire & Rescue Authority for unnecessary fire alarms will be charged accordingly.
- Please ensure your friends are aware of your unit number so reception is able to contact you. Your direct phone extension number will be issued to you on your arrival. You will be unable to make external calls from your unit, unless a valid credit card number is provided at the time of check-in.
