

## More Stem-changing Verbs

The following verbs all have an **o that changes to ue** in all but the nosotros and vosotros forms.

Example: dormir -- to sleep  
**duermo**            **dormimos**  
**duerme**           **dormís**  
**duerme**           **duermen**



almorzar	to eat lunch
colgar	to hang (up)
contar	to count
demonstrar	to show, demonstrate
doler	to hurt, ache
encontrar	to find (think: encounter)
llover*	to rain
mostrar	to show
probar	to prove, test, sample, taste
resolver	to solve
soler	to be accustomed to
tostar	to toast
volver	to return

aprobar	to approve
conmover	to move (emotionally)
costar*	to cost
devolver	to return, give back
dormir	to sleep
envolver	to wrap (up) (think: envelop)
morder	to bite
poder	to be able, can
recordar	to remember
rogar	to beg, to pray
soñar (con)	to dream (about)
tronar*	to thunder
volar	to fly

\* verbs with limited conjugations ( can you ever say "we rain"?)

The verbs below have an **e that changes to an i** in all but the nosotros and vosotros forms.

\*\*Notice that all these verbs end in -ir, and that some of them are from your -go verbs list!

Example: pedir -- to request, to ask for  
**pido**                    **pedimos**  
**pides**                **pedís**  
**pide**                 **piden**

impedir	to impede, to hinder
medir	to be long, to measure
reír	to laugh
repetir	to repeat
servir	to serve
vestir	to dress
