Mini-Progress Report

Kindergarten students are working on recognizing the sound and producing the sound they see each letter of the alphabet. Each student was assessed on identifying lowercase and uppercase letters as well as producing the sound to match.

Some sounds prove to be a bit tricky to remember (e, u, y), so please review this with your child nightly this week or until they have mastered it. Thank you for taking the time to help your child with this specific skill. I am including a copy of our alphabet chart on the back to help you review each sound.

- Wow! You can identify all of the letters and their sounds! Way to go! You can use the flash cards to play pretend school!
- If you see a highlighted letter, you need some more practice with identifying these letters. I need to know what they are each called!
If you see a highlighted letter on the alphabet chart, I need some more practice with producing the sound to match these letters. I need to know what sound these letters make!
