Satin Ribbon Angel Pin Craft Kit

Plastic Canvas Tips: Try to keep the ribbon flat and from twisting when threading the ribbon through the plastic canvas holes. Pull the ribbon firmly between holes. It is helpful to tape or stiffen ribbon ends with white glue to make threading easier.

Pink & Purple Angel Pin

- 1 Leave a 1" ribbon tail at the back of the angel. Begin by threading the purple ribbon through hole 1 and then continue to hole 2 and return through hole 1. Follow the numbered squares on the plastic canvas diagram always going back through hole 1 by following this sequence: 1,2,1,3,1,4,1,5,1,6. Continue alternating the ribb on diagonally until hole 6. Return though hole1. Cut off excess ribbon and glue to secure.
- 2.Leave a 1" ribbon tail at the back of the angel. Thread the pink ribbon through hole A and then continue to hole B and return through hole A. Follow the lettered squares on the plastic canvas diagram always going back through hole A by following this sequence: A,B,A,C,A,D,A,E. Continue alternating the ribbon diagonally until hole E Return though hole A. Cut off excess ribbon and glue to secure.
- 3. Leave a 1" ribbon tail at the back of the angel. Thread the white ribbon through hole 7 and then crntinue to hole 8. Follow the numbered squares on the plastic canvas diagram. Continue alternating the ribbon diagonally until hole 19. After threading hole 19, wrap the ribbon into an "X" shape over the middle square. Cut off excess ribbon and glue to secure.
- 4. Glue the pearl head to the top of the plastic canvas. Glue the ends of the gold bead string together to form the halo and glue the halo to the back of the pearl head.
- 5. Finish by gluing the pin to the back of the angel. Allow time for your pin to dry.
