



## HOW TO PLAY SCATTERGORIES:

1. Cut apart the letters on the bottom of this page and place into a hat or small bowl. Have someone close their eyes and pick out a letter.
2. Set a timer for 3 minutes. If you are playing with younger children, you may want to set the timer for a little bit longer.
3. Using the categories cards, each player will fill in answers that start with the previously selected letter. This set includes categories cards for 2 rounds of the game.
4. Write down as many answers as you can before the time runs out. If you get stuck on one, feel free to skip and return back to it later if time allows.
5. When the timer runs out, go around the room and compare answers with the other players. If someone has the same answer as you, you both must cross it off your list. Whoever has the most unique answers at the end of the game wins!
