-MATERIALS LIST

- 1/4 yd or 1 fat quarter fabric* for elephant
- 1/4 yd light-weight, fusible, woven interfacing, 20"+ wide
- Wool-blend felt scraps for star, heart, or flower decoration (optional)
- Embroidery thread, or 2 small buttons for flower centers (optional)
- Embroidery thread, or 2 small buttons for eyes
- · Stuffing
- Thread

HELPFUL TOOLS

Pins, scissors, needles, iron, seam ripper, water-soluble marker, narrow turning tool (such as Dritz® Loop Turner), stuffing tool (such as Stuffing Fork™ or chopstick)

* Suitable fabrics include quilting-weight cotton, light-weight decorator fabric, and other light- to medium-weight woven fabrics. Do not use stretchy fabrics such as wovens with lycra, or knits.
