Excuse me, officer. Is there a Post Office near here?

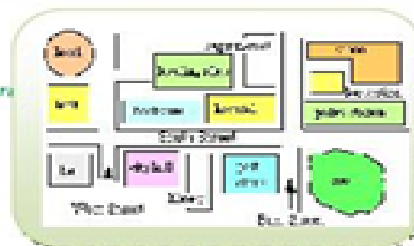
Er... There's one in East Street, opposite the Zoo.
