Paper Airplane Next, fold down along line No.2. At the seam where the wings meet use a piece of Scotch tape to hold them together. Add a standard paper clip beside the nose to balance the weight of the thinner nose with the plane's wide wings. First, fold the wings down along line No. 1. Grab the tail in the center and fold it in the opposite direction along the same line, so it extends above the wings. Last, fold the flaps up along line No.3. 3
