### Frog Vocabulary

**Amphibian:** An animal that can live both on land and in water.

**Adaptation:** A change in an organism that helps it survive in its environment.

**Environment:** The natural world around an organism, including the air, water, and land it lives in.

**Survival:** The ability of an organism to stay alive and healthy in its environment.

**Reproduction:** The process by which an organism produces offspring.

**Development:** The process by which an organism grows and changes over time.

**Life Cycle:** The series of stages that an organism goes through from birth to death.

**Stage:** A part of a process or a series of events.

**Stage 1:** The first stage of the frog's life cycle, where the egg is laid.

**Stage 2:** The second stage of the frog's life cycle, where the egg hatches into a tadpole.

**Stage 3:** The third stage of the frog's life cycle, where the tadpole grows and develops into a froglet.

**Stage 4:** The final stage of the frog's life cycle, where the froglet grows into a fully formed frog.
