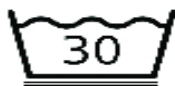
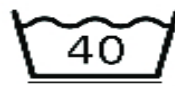

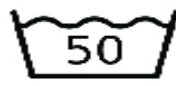
Washing



Very Gentle Wash at 30°C



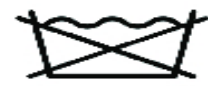
Gentle Wash at 40°C

Professional Clean Only

- Numbers within the washing symbol denote the maximum temperature
- Lines beneath symbols denote a gentle wash or spin. More lines mean a gentler wash
- The letters I and P within a circle provide professional chemical cleaning instructions.
- The letter W in a circle denotes professional wet cleaning instruction

Tumble Dry (Low Heat)



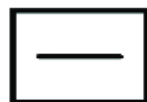
Tumble Dry (Normal Heat)

Drip

- A circle in the square symbolises a dryer
- Tumble drying temperature is explained by the number of dots.
- The more dots, the higher the heat accepted.

- A square without a circle inside symbolises that the item must be dried naturally.
- Diagonal lines in the top left corner explain that the item must be dried in the shade.

Do Not Iron

- The number of dots equates to temperature
- One dot for 110°C
- Two dots for 150°C
- Three dots for 200°C
