

FROSTY THE SNOWMAN

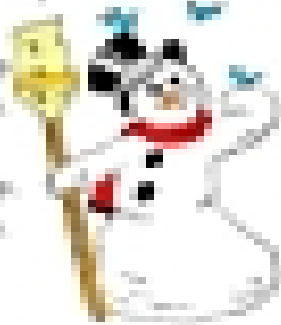
Frosty the snowman
