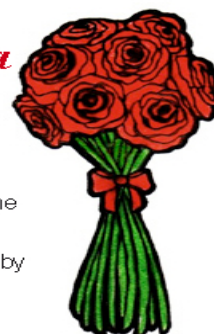


A Rose By Any Other Name trivia
