

# Family Rules and Consequences

Behavior	Consequence
<b>Destructive</b>	Replace with Money or Work
<b>Irresponsible</b>	No Privileges Outside the Home
<b>Big Messes</b>	They are in Charge of Cleaning it Up
<b>Poor Behavior with Others</b>	Learn to Say Sorry
<b>Not Obeying Babysitter</b>	Make Them Pay You Back
<b>Bedtime Troubles</b>	Earlier Bedtime the Next Night
<b>Whining &amp; Crying</b>	Time Away to Get Composure

Behavior	Consequence
<b>Not Caring for Things</b>	Things Taken Away Temporarily or Permanently
<b>Talking Back</b>	"Try it Again."
<b>Spitting</b>	Clean-Up and Time Away
<b>Hitting</b>	Time Out
<b>Interrupting</b>	Wait 5 minutes before they get to engage with you.

All consequences should be given in a calm, cool voice. Kids should be given consequences when it is a reoccurring behavior. Consequences should be accompanied with relevant scripture memorization. There should be apologies with forgiveness granted.
