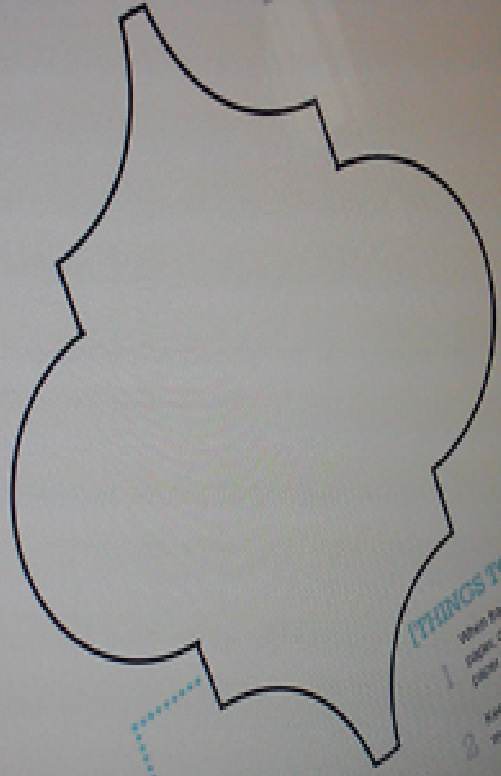


# WINDOW STEP

7th House on the Left



## (THINGS TO REMEMBER)

1. When placing the stencil onto the contact paper, make sure the paper side, not contact paper, faces out.
2. Keep the stencil taut. This will give you a much clearer cut.
3. Check the entire stencil and paper you cut. After you finish applying your line, lift up the stencil and see if the window side is on the wall or not.
4. When peeling the contact paper backing, do it slowly. If the contact paper comes off, you can use it all over again on the window. If you have a hole, you can use it to make a new one.
