



Talos Elixior



- 2 Drops stag juice
- 5 Leaves of Devil's Snare
- 1 Fire opital - crushed
- 2 Crocodile Tears
- 1 Pinch blessing seeds (Aigella works well)
- 1 Piece of dragons scale
- 4 Drops of doves blood
- 1 Wormwood grubb
- 2 Hairs from a Fire Tarnatula

Put the stag juice in vile, agitate till the liquids separate. Pour only the milky oil into the pot, discard yellow solid. Devil's snare is easily cut when in the sun light but has a nasty thorn in shade. Add snare to the pot and mix well. If the mixture doesn't turn green add another leaf. Pour the crocodile tears in one at a time and mix well between. Allow the brew to simmer at this stage for one week. Should now have a blue colored brew that smells sweetly of honey. Remove from heat and mix in the blessing seeds. It's vigorously to keep from fermenting over. Add both the dragons scale and doves blood. Mix well and let steep for an hour. Now add the wormwood grubb. May need to open the windows. These grubbs are known for their heavy pungent odor. Remove from heat at this point and allow to cool for another week. When ready the mix should still be bubbling and carry a slight odor. Add the Tarnatula hairs and cover immediately. This will need to sit for another week before use.
