PLANNING CHECKLIST

15-9 months out

- START A WEDDING BINDER AND AN ONLINE WEDDING INSPIRATION BOARD** (i.e. pinterest)
Use the binder to collect all wedding paperwork, ideas and inspiration, samples, business cards, receipts and contracts. It is always important to keep yourself organized and efficient. Use your binder to collect the wedding ideas and inspiration that you find online.
- FINALIZE YOUR OVERALL BUDGET**
Determine who will contribute financially to the wedding and how much you will have to spend.
- SELECT YOUR WEDDING PARTY**
- START CREATING YOUR GUEST LIST**
It's a good idea to put your list in spreadsheet format.
- HIRE A PLANNER**
If your budget allows, this is money well spent. Simply put, planners are experts and who can help you when planning such an important event.
- DECIDE ON YOUR VENUE(S) AND DATE**
Before moving on, this has to be completed. Find the perfect spot, or spots if your ceremony and reception will not be at the same venue, and then select a date.
