Time to grill up for spring

If you will be grilling for a cookout with this year's barbecue king you'll want to:

• Wash your grill thoroughly after each use and before you use it again. Don't let debris or ash collect on the surface. Burner gas is the main ingredient for a flame, so don't let debris or ash collect on top of it. This leaves propane, which is the main propane burner.

• When storing the propane tank, keep it away from heat sources and avoid standing on it. Never store propane tanks near the entrance to a house or in an enclosed area.

• If you're cooking outside, make sure to have a fire extinguisher nearby. You never know what could happen.

• Clean your propane tank with a mixture of water and vinegar to clean. This is safe because vinegar is acidic.

• Propane tanks can last for 10 years and it costs to clean. That is why it is safe to clean.

• If you are buying a new barbecue you will need one with the burner to go "off" automatically when the "off" button is pushed.

• Make sure to use a propane torch to clean your propane tank. This is the best way to get rid of debris and to clean your propane tank.

• Other barbecue accessories include a barbecue stand or barbecue table which will allow you to barbecue outside.

• Make sure to barbecue in a safe area, away from trees, houses, propane tanks and propane tanks.
