- Modifications/Alterations
- Adjusted waist level - raised up
 - Attached 2" wide band w/ elastic curving to waist, so the middle of the band sits on the waist.
 - Changed curve of front crotch to more of an "L" shape.
 - Waist band: 33 1/2" (5" SA) x 5" wide (84.8 cm)
 - Elastic: 32" cut (incl. 1" SA) cut 33" (82.3 cm)
 - Side seams @ 22.5 cm from CB.
