Warning stage	Interrupting teaching Interrupting children's learning by talking at the wrong time, ignoring minor instructions, pushing in the line. (low level misdemeanours)	Eye contact Frown Reminders Changing seat Warning about their behaviour and in danger of going onto stage 1
Stage 1	Failure to respond to teacher's request Creating a disturbance Accidental damage through carelessness Minor challenges to authority. Annoying other children	Separation from the group and a mark recorded on the class behaviour list.
Stage 2	If poor behaviour continues and the teaching is interrupted in the same day. Leaving the room without permission. Rudeness to adults. Defiance	Sent to partner class. In the partner class they will write a letter of apology to their class teacher and stay for a maximum of 15mins. Parents/carers usually informed by teacher. Regular stage 2 behaviour may be supported by class target card or Personal support plan, written with SENCO
Stage 3	If their behaviour continues for a second time in the same fashion or if this is the first occasion of a more serious nature i.e. swearing at staff, fighting.	S.L.T must be informed, a letter may go home to parents/carers. The child may be put on to the Turn Around programme by the Headteacher. They may be excluded.
