

Free printable **MOVING CHECKLIST**



4 Weeks before Moving Day

- Check with your insurance company to confirm your possessions are covered during transit.
- Schedule connection of utility services at your new home, including electricity, water, sewage, cable, Internet, telephone and trash disposal service.
- Schedule the disconnection of utility services at your old home.
- File a change of address with the US Postal Service and pick up an official USPS Mover's Guide at your local Post Office.
- Purchase locks for your new home or arrange to have them installed.
- Arrange for cleaning service.
- Make any necessary telephone calls.
- Gather personal and financial documents.



2 Weeks before Moving Day

- Return any borrowed items.
- Prepare auto registers.
- Order new checks as needed.



1 Week before Moving Day

- Send change-of-address cards to everyone who will need to contact you.
- Assemble a backpack with your checkbook, credit cards, phone records, identification flashlight, keys, mobile phone charger, small camera, toiletries, paper plates and cups, towels, travel alarm clock, bottled water, first aid kit and games for the kids.
- Pack a suitcase with clothing and other personal items.
- Make child care arrangements for moving day.



The Day before Moving Day

- Transfer your bank account if necessary.
- Have an adequate amount of cash for any travel expenses you cannot pay for with a credit card.
- Empty, defrost and clean your refrigerator and freezer at least 24 hours before moving day.
