Plant Vocabulary

A plant is a living organism that grows in soil and has green leaves. It has a stem, roots, and flowers. The roots are underground and help the plant absorb water and nutrients from the soil. The stem is the main part of the plant that supports the leaves and flowers. The leaves are green and use sunlight to make food for the plant. The flowers are the reproductive part of the plant and produce seeds. The seeds are small and hard and can grow into new plants. The plant grows and changes over time. It has a life cycle that starts with a seed and ends with a fully grown plant that produces more seeds.

Parts of a Plant



Flower
The flower makes seeds for the plant.

Leaves
Leaves make food for the plant. They have a surface that catches sunlight and releases oxygen.

Stem
The stem supports the plant. It contains tubes for carrying food, minerals and water.

Roots
The roots soak up water and minerals. They also store food for the plant.
