This collection of worksheets is designed for young learners and includes the following components:

- Top Left Section:**
  - "What is today?": A color-by activity for days of the week (Sunday through Saturday).
  - "What is tomorrow?": Another color-by activity for days of the week.
  - "What is today's date?": A space to write the date.
  - "What is the season?": A color-by activity for seasons (Spring, Summer, Fall, Winter).
  - "Today is the \_\_\_ day of school": A section with boxes for "hundreds", "tens", and "ones".
- Top Middle Section:**
