Answer: Springfield, Massachusetts.

11. Question: What was Dr. Seuss's last book for children?
Answer: 'Oh, The Places You'll Go' was his last published book before death.

12. Question: Do all books of Dr. Seuss rhyme?
Answer: Yes.

13. Question: Who finished Dr. Seuss's unfinished books?
Answer: Cathy goldsmith, who worked with Dr. Seuss, on his last six books, completed his last unfinished book after his death.

14. Question: What was the name of Dr. Seuss's last unfinished book?
Answer: 'What Pet Should I Get'.

Answer: 'The Cat In The Hat' and 'Green Eggs And Ham'.
