Toilet

- Leave a denture tablet in the toilet bowl overnight to remove stains.
- Careful, don't mix bleach with toilet bowl cleaners.
- Get tough stains with extra-fine sandpaper or steel wool.



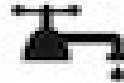
Shower/Bath tub

- Pull the shower curtain closed when not in use, so water can't sit in the folds.
- To unclog your showerhead, fill a plastic bag with white vinegar and place it over the head, securing with a rubber band. Soak overnight, then scrub with a toothbrush.
- Clean those bath toys! Give them a vinegar-water bath. Y'all said.



Tile/Walls

- Rub grout with lemon wedges to get out mold.
- Wallpaper: scrub lightly with a damp sponge dipped in baking soda. Vacuum powder off when dry.



Sink

- Clean chrome fixtures with rubbing alcohol.
- Don't use an abrasive sponge on the fixtures.
- Fill the sink with hot water and soak to loosen grime.

Floors

- Bathroom floors are gross (that's not a tip).
- On floors last, a vacuum works better than a broom.
- Bathmats catch junk and are easy to rotate once a week.

Miscellaneous

- Place a dryer sheet in the bottom of the trash to absorb smells.
- Switch to glycerin soap to reduce soap scum.
- Run the bath fan or crack a window when showering to prevent mold.

DIY Cleaners

- Tub & Tile** - 1:1 vinegar:water
- Mirrors/Glass** - undiluted vinegar, or 1/2 cup cornstarch in 2 qts. water
- Drain** - 1/2 baking soda/vinegar
- Hairer** - 1/4 cup vinegar & 1/4 cup Borax dissolved in warm water

Daily:

- Wipe sink, toilet seat, & mirror
- Spray curtain or shower door with daily cleanser (1:1 baking soda/vinegar/water)

Weekly:

- Scrub the tub, shower & tile
- Scrub toilet
- Vacuum & mop the floor
- Wipe down sink, counters & mirrors
- Empty the trash

Quarterly:

- Launder shower curtain
- Clean out medicine cabinet
- Deep tub/toilet/sink scrub
- Clean plunger/toilet brush
- Disinfect waste basket
- Vacuum ventilator cover
- Scrub grout
