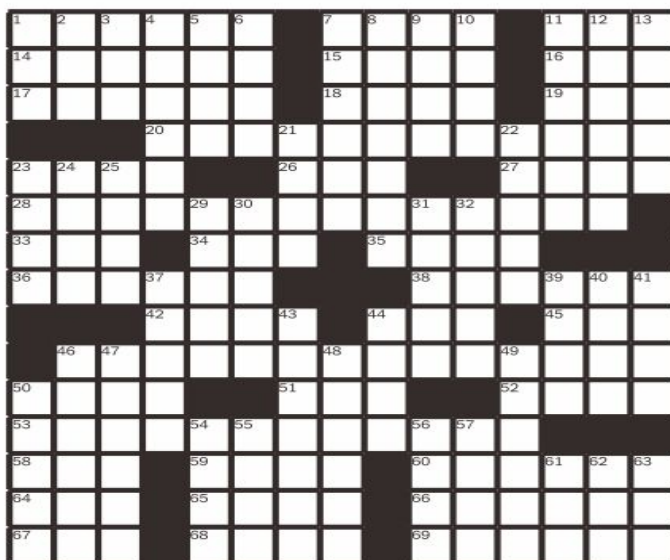
CELEBRITY CROSSWORD
