Weight: the measurement of the heaviness of an object

16 ounces = 1 pound
2,000 pounds = 1 short ton

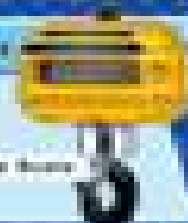
Kitchen Scale

Temperatures:

32° Fahrenheit = water freezes
212° Fahrenheit = water boils

the measurement of how hot an object is solid, liquid, or gas is

Capacity:

the measurement of the largest amount that an object can contain

8 fluid ounces = 1 cup = 236.6 fluid ounces
16 fluid ounces = 1 pint = 473.2 fluid ounces
2 cups = 1 pint = 16 fluid ounces
4 pints = 1 quart = 32 fluid ounces
4 quarts = 1 gallon = 128 fluid ounces

the measurement of an object from one end to the other

Distances:

the measurement between two objects

12 inches = 1 foot
3 feet = 1 yard
5,280 feet = 1 mile
