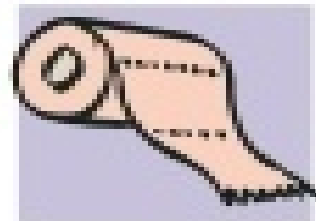




Feeling Flush Toilet Trivia
