



## Retro Doll Accessories

Inspired by fashions of the 1960s, these crocheted doll accessories will add fun to an 18" doll's wardrobe. Use self-striping sock yarn to make the Spring Vest extra colorful. Lacy Hat and Very Berry Bag are crocheted in coordinating solids.

Clothes designed for 18" doll.

Hat circumference: 13".

Bag: 4½" wide x 4" high.

Vest Chest Measurement: 11½".

Vest Length: 6".

**Lacy Hat and Very Berry Bag:** RED HEART® "Soft Yarn"; 1 ball 9522 Leaf for Hat; 1 ball each 9779 Berry A and 9522 Leaf B for Bag.

**Spring Vest:** RED HEART® "Heart & Sole" with Aloe; 1 ball 3960 Spring Stripe.

**Crochet Hook:** 5mm [US H-8]. Yarn needle, sewing needle and thread; three ½" over-shaped buttons for Hat; 2 stitch markers, one shank button for Bag.

**Crochet Hook:** 4mm [US G-6]. Yarn needle, sewing needle and thread; three ½" over-shaped buttons in assorted colors.

**GAUGES:** With larger hook and Soft Yarn: 6 V-sts = 4"; 8 rounds = 4" for Hat; 14 sts = 4"; 12 rows = 4" in pattern for Bag. With smaller hook and Heart and Sole Yarn 17 sts = 4"; 16 rows = 4" in sc. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hooks to obtain the gauges.

### LACY LEAF HAT

#### Special Abbreviation

V-st = (dc, ch 1, dc) in same space.

Ch 3; join with a slip st to form a ring.

**Round 1:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1 throughout); [dc in ring, ch 1] 7 times; join with a slip st in 3rd ch of ch-4 - 8 ch-1 spaces.

**Round 2:** Slip st in next ch-1 space, ch 1, (sc, ch 3, sc) in same space and in each ch-1 space around; join with a slip st in 1st sc - 8 ch-3 spaces.

**Round 3:** Slip st in next ch-3 space, ch 4, V-st in same space, [(dc, ch 1, V-st) in next ch-3 space] 7 times; join in 3rd ch of ch-4 - 16 ch-1 spaces.

**Round 4:** Repeat Round 2 - 16 ch-3 spaces.

**Round 5:** Slip st in next ch-3 space, ch 4, dc in same space, [V-st in next ch-3 space] 15 times; join in 3rd ch of ch-4 - 16 Vsts.

**Round 6:** Repeat Round 2.

**Round 7:** Slip st in next ch-3 space, ch 1, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-3 space and in each ch-3 space around; join.

**Round 8:** Slip st in next ch-3 space, ch 1, 2 sc in same space and in each ch-3 space around; join - 32 sc.

**Round 9:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join.

**Brim-Round 10:** Ch 1, sc in 1st sc, 2 sc in next sc, hdc in next sc, 2 hdc in next sc, hdc in next sc, 2 dc in next 2 sc, dc in next sc, 2 hdc in next sc, hdc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc; TURN leaving remaining sts unworked.

### Brim Edging

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in 1st st, sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st, dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts. Fasten off.

### finSHinG

With sewing need and thread, sew buttons to front of brim following photo as guide. Weave in ends.

### VERY BERRY BAG

**Row 1 (Right Side):** With A, ch 24; sc in 2nd ch from hook; [hdc in next ch, sc in next ch] 11 times; turn - 23 sts.

**Row 2:** Ch 2 (counts as hdc throughout), working in front loops only, hdc in 1st st, [sc in next st, hdc in next st] 11 times; turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, working in back loops only, sc in 1st st, [hdc in next st, sc in next st] 11 times; turn.

**Rows 4-9:** Repeat Rows 2 and 3 three more times. Fasten off after Row 9.

### Border

**Round 1:** With right side facing, join B with sc in 1st st on last row of bag; work 2 more sc in same sc, sc in next 11 sts, mark last st made, sc in next 10 sts, 3 sc in last st; working over post of st at row ends, work 9 sc to next corner; working in remaining loops of beginning ch, 3 sc in 1st st, sc in next 11 sts, mark last st made, sc in next 10 sts, 3 sc in last st; working over post of st at row ends, work 9 sc to next corner; join with a slip st in 3rd ch of ch-4. Fasten off.

### Assembly

**Row 1:** With wrong sides together, fold bag in half at markers, join A with a slip st in 1st marked st at fold; working through both thicknesses at same time, [ch 1, slip st in next sc] 12 times; for strap [ch 2, slip st in 2nd ch from hook] 16 times; taking care not to twist strap, working in sts on opposite side of bag border and through both thicknesses at the same time, slip st in center sc of 3-sc group, [ch 1, slip st in next sc] to 2nd marker. Fasten off. Remove stitch markers.

### flap

**Row 1 (Right Side):** Join B with a slip st in center of side seam behind strap; working in back loops only in sc across top of bag, sc in next 2 sc, hdc in next 2 sc, dc in next sc, 3 dc in next sc, dc in next sc, hdc in next 2 sc, dc in next 2 sc, sc, slip st in center of second side seam; turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, working in front loops only, sc in 1st 2 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, dc in next 3 sts, 3 dc in next st, dc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, sc in last 2 sts, slip st in center of

side seam; turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, working in both loops, sc in 1st 2 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, dc in next 4 sts, for buttonhole [dc, ch 1, dc] in next st, dc in next 4 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, sc in next 2 sts, slip st in center of side seam. Fasten off.

### flap Trim

With right side facing, join A with a slip st in center of side seam, [ch 1, slip st in next st] 9 times, slip st in ch-1 space, [ch 1, slip st in next st] 9 times, ch 1, slip st in center of side seam. Fasten off.

### finSHinG

With sewing needle and matching thread, sew button to front of flap lined up with buttonhole. Weave in ends.

### SPRING STRIPES VEST

#### Special Abbreviations

V-st = (dc, ch 3, dc) in same st or space.

sc2tog = [draw up a loop in next st] twice, yo and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

### Front Edging and Button Loops

With right side still facing, ch 1, working over post of st at row ends, sc in 1st row, 2 sc in next row, sc in next row; for button loops [(sc, ch 3, sc) in next row, sc in next 2 rows] 3 times; sc in each row to back neck, sc in each st across back, working in row ends of opposite side, sc in each row to last 2 rows on Lower Border, 2 sc in next row, sc in last row. Fasten off.

**Rows 7-14:** Repeat Rows 3-6 twice more - 7 sc. Fasten off.

### Lower Border

**Row 1:** With right side facing, working in remaining loops of beginning ch, join yarn with sc in 1st st. V-st in next st, skip next st, sc in next st, skip next st, repeat from across, end at ; turn - 12 Vsts.

**Row 2:** Ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3, dc in 1st sc, [sc in ch-3 space of next V-st, V-st in next sc] 12 times; turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, slip st in ch-3 space of next V-st, ch 1, sc in same space, [V-st in next sc, sc in ch-3 space of next V-st] 12 times; do not turn but pivot to work Front Edging.

**ABBREVIATIONS:** A, B = color A, B; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; hdc = half double crochet; mm = millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); tog = together; \* or \*\* = repeat whatever follows the or as indicated; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times spec'd.

### Armhole Edging

**Round 1:** With right side facing, join A with sc in 1st st on right side of armhole opening, sc in next st, working over post of st at row ends, sc in each row around armhole opening, join with a slip st in 1st sc - 30 sc.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, sc in 1st sc, skip next 2 sc, V-st in next sc, sc, skip next 2 sc, [sc in next sc, skip next 2 sc, V-st in next sc, sc, skip next 2 sc] 4 times; join in 1st sc.

**Round 3:** Ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3, dc in same sc, sc in ch-3 space of next V-st, [V-st in next sc, sc in ch-3 space of next V-st] 4 times; join in 3rd ch of ch-6. Fasten off.

### finSHinG

With sewing needle and matching thread, attach buttons to left front aligned with button loops. Weave in ends.
