

13 Sweet Articles of Faith



1. We believe in God the Eternal Father, and in His Only Son Jesus Christ, and in the Holy Ghost.
2. We believe that Jesus will be present with His saints, and will be their Advocate.
3. We believe that through the instrumentality of Christ, all mankind may be saved by returning to the love and obedience of the Gospel.
4. We believe that the first principles and fundamentals of the Christian Faith, taught in the New Testament, are: Repentance; Baptism; the remission of sins; Death; Living and glorious Resurrection at the last day.
5. We believe that it is our duty to call on God for prosperity, and for the happiness of men by those who are in authority throughout the world; and particularly of the children of men.
6. We believe in the true prophecies that concern us the Prophets, namely: Moses, prophet, lawgiver, evangelist, and author.
7. We believe in the gift of tongues, prophesying, interpretation, working of miracles, and in such.
8. We believe the Sabbath to be the sign of God's seal to His covenant people; and also, above the Sabbath, to be the seal of God.
9. We believe all that God has revealed, all that He has given us, and her belief that He will yet reveal many great and important things pertaining to the Kingdom of God.
10. We believe in the third gathering of Israel, and in the conversion of the New Hebrews that shall then have (according to his just judgment) the nations converted, that Israel will most personally receive the birth, and that the earth will be renewed and receive its promised glory.
11. We claim the privilege of interpreting the Word of God according to the dictates of our own consciences, and above all men this great privilege, of being recording these words, for which they stand.
12. We believe in having added unto these promises, gifts, and dispensations, including crowning, and consecrating the last.

We believe in being reward, and whose, hereunto, witness and in doing good to all men, before, and after, and that we follow the admonition of Paul, to labour for the love of things, we have received many things, and hope to be able to endure all things, if there is anything wherein finally, we offend, misery or punishment, we must suffer those things.
