Crochet Barbie Skirt Pattern







This crochet skirt goes to the knees but you can make it longer by repeating rnd 12.

A snap fastener is used in the back. Happy Crocheting!

You will need:

- crochet cotton thread (I used ciruculo clea but you can use any brand you prefer)
- 1.7mm hook
- 3/8" snap, or fastener of your choosing.

Abbreviations:

ch chain

sc single crochet

dc double crochet

rnd round

scinc single crochet increase

st stitch

sl st slip stitch

f/o fasten off

shell: 5 double crochet stitches into the same stitch

Instructions:

ch 34, pull tight on last ch.

row 1: sc into 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. (33 st)

row 2: sc across 33 st, ch 1, pull tight, turn.

row 3: sc 3, (sc 2, scinc, sc 2) x 6, ch 1, pull tight, turn. (39 st)

row 4-6: sc 39 over sts, ch 1, pull tight, turn.

row 7: sc 39 over st, do not turn.

*From here we will start working in the rnd.

sc into 4th st of row 7, sc 32 over next st, sc last 3 st with rnd 8: the skipped first 3 st of row: going through the skipped st

first then the last st. (36st)

rnd 9: (sc, scinc, sc) x 12, ch 1, pull tight.

rnd 10: (sc, skip 2 st, shell, skip 2 st) x 8, sl st join to first st. (48 st)

rnd 11: ch 3, dc 2 into same st, (skip 2 st, sc, skip 2 st, shell) x 11,

skip 2 st, sc, skip 2 st, dc 2 into first st.

rnd repeat rnds 10 & 11 alternately ending with rnd 10. Keep

12-20: going until you reach the length you like.

rnd 21: $(sc, (sc, ch 3) \times 4, sc] \times 8$, sl st join to first st, f/o.

Weave in ends. Sew on snap or fastener of your choosing.

And there you have it. An simple crochet barbie skirt!
