



ALPHABET:

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Teaching Tips:

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
This interactive worksheets will help your students to learn about the correct formation of letters.

Guide your students by following these directions to finish the worksheet.

- 1. Let them take their seat and prepare their stationery needs on the table neatly.
- 2. Ask your students to trace the drawing and write their name at the top of the worksheet page.
- 3. Guide your students by assisting them verbally to start by putting their pencil on the first letter as it is shown with a circle.
- 4. Tell your students to follow the lines on the first letter in correct formation with their pencil. It can be a stroke down, back up or curve around.
- 5. Let your students complete each line of letters by using this technique then guide them to write on their own.
- 6. Be sure to accompany your students completing the worksheet Students are allowed to add more details on each picture. Students can add their own writing of a line for each focus letter.









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
